



high risk moderate risk low risk negligible risk




Current tracks and intensities of tropical cyclones (hurricanes)

Predicted tracks and intensities of tropical cyclones (hurricanes) in the future in the Caribbean and Atlantic Ocean as a result of climate change





The year with the highest water level 'above flood stage' of the River Mississippi at a number of points







Homicide (murder) rates per 100000 people for 2011






Infant mortality rates for 1990 and 2012 for selected geographical regions
